- What sort of newspaper do you need?

And connects affirmative sentences together.

Ex: I like tea. I like Coffee.

• I like tea and coffee.

But connects controversial sentences together.

• I like tea, but I don't like coffee.

So connects sentences that are cause and effect.

• I didn't study hard so I didn't pass the exam.
