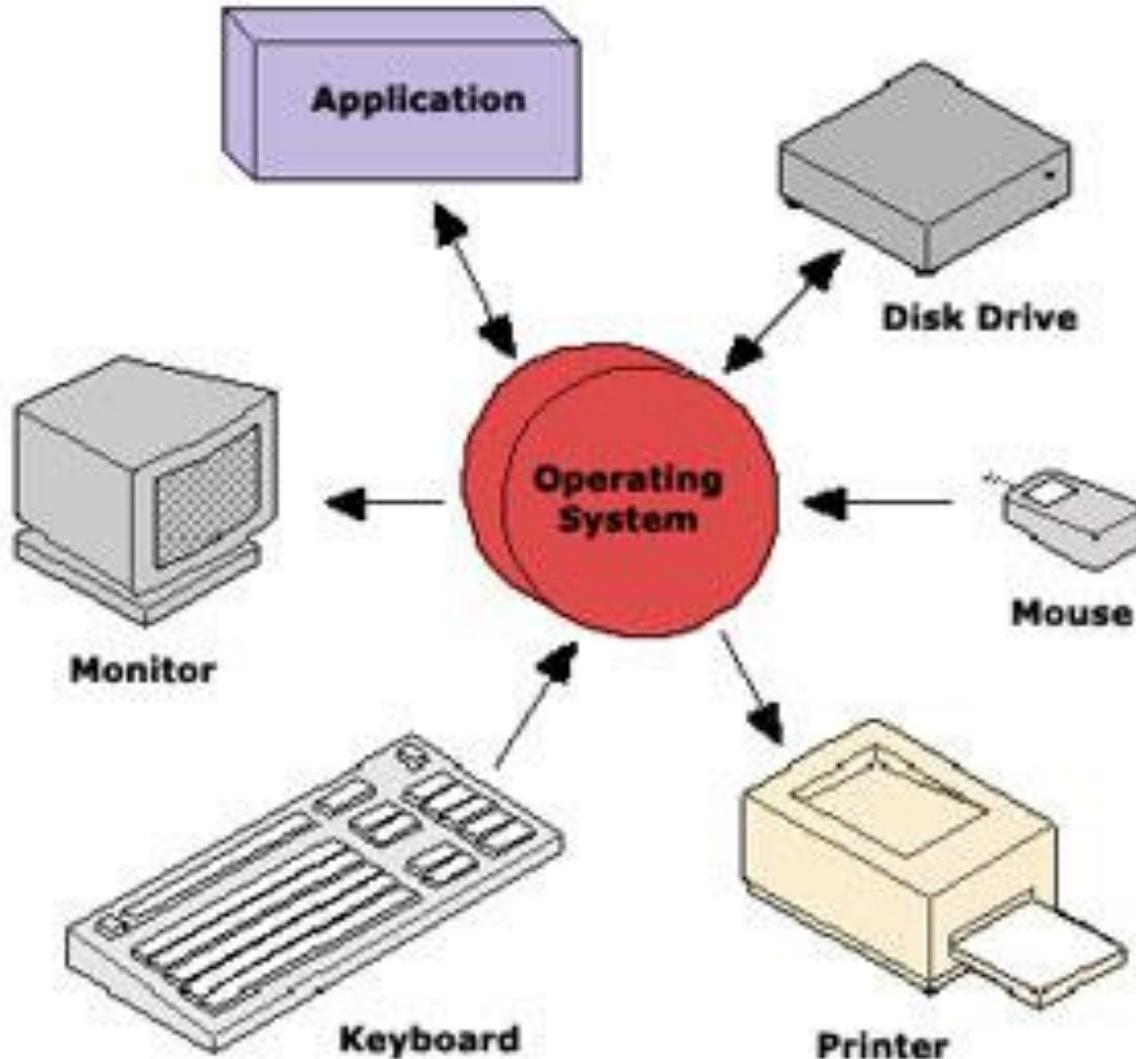

Operating systems

- ▶ OP a set of software that controls and communicates with the computers physical components, and provides a set of common services for the software applications that downloaded after it.



Tasks of operating system



Objectives of operating system

- ▶ Facilitating communication between the user and the computer
- ▶ Automated computer resources management
- ▶ Finding a safe and suitable space on the memory to exchange the required information.
- ▶ Laying to carry out the task and save the processor time to carry out this task.

Objectives of operating system

- ▶ Providing the opportunity to perform more than one task at a time.
- ▶ Providing the ability to participate on a single device from a user bug.
- ▶ Take advantage of the available resources inside the device

Classification of operating systems

- ▶ First: According to the nature of OS's
 1. Build in operating system
 2. Non-integrated flexible operating system
- ▶ Second: According to the tasks
 1. Multitasking
 2. Single task.
- ▶ Third : According to the users.
 1. Multi-Users
 2. Single-User
