

E- MAGAZINE (E-ZINE)

Electronic magazine or e-zine which also called web-zine. It is a magazine that contains electronic articles that are stored on a file server, and distributed by any electronic method via a website or an email newsletter.

ADVANTAGES OF ELECTRONIC MAGAZINES

- •Provides greater credibility.
- •Transfer speed and display news.
- •Direct interaction between editor and reader.
- Provide a chance for journalists to work remotely in the largest regional.

ADVANTAGES OF ELECTRONIC MAGAZINES

- •Depend on declaration as a main source of profits.
- •Achieve a wider spread than traditional magazines.

PROBLEMS AND OBSTACLES WITH ELECTRONIC MAGAZINES

- The lack of an electronic environment to receive e magazines in some libraries.
- The high subscription fees for some electronic magazines may force libraries to cancel their subscription.

PROBLEMS AND OBSTACLES WITH ELECTRONIC MAGAZINES

- Difficulty reading some electronic texts.
- oAuthors' rights are not guaranteed in electronic magazines (Issues of scientific plagiarism).

PROBLEMS AND OBSTACLES WITH ELECTRONIC MAGAZINES


- •Waste of time if Internet connection is bad or slow.



- Linking citations and references to bibliographic database or to fulltext articles make it more useful.
